Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc

Garnet in color. Cherry, sandalwood, a sweet cocoa butter aroma is the dominant theme with subtle hints of tobacco, campfire and green peppercorn. The wine has a medium body and cherry again being the dominant fruit. Fruit follows through with a prolonged chalky finish.

JS 89-The 2015 Trellis is a dark red to garnet color. The bright, clean aromatic nose contains cherry, sandalwood and subtle raspberry notes well framed by hints of campfire and suspicions of vanilla. It is medium bodied with silky texture and olfactory notes like its aromas reinforcing the fine tannin structure.

JS 91-Dark garnet in color. The nose exhibits a density of dark fruits, strong toast, and mouth coating tannin. All-spice and vanilla frame the aromatic bouquet, a variable abundance of flavors such as blackberry, blueberry and currant leaf. It is a full-bodied wine with well-structured tannin that melds with berry fruits which shine through the mid-palate.

JS 93-The 2015 Reserve has a deep ruby color. The bouquet is intense, reflecting dense and complex layers of black fruit and toasted French oak. Black currant and dark cherry fold into exotic notes of cardamom, spice and cigar box. The finish has great length and depth, lingering with chalky tannin and dark fruits – altogether a wide range of intricate flavor from beginning to end.

Sauvignon Blanc

A pale lemon color reflects an overall citrusy bouquet and flavor profile, captured by bursts of fresh, bright acidity. Lemons and lime zest, as well as passionfruit and pear dance along the mid-palate, accentuated by a creamy and luxurious finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, Malbec, Petit Verdot

RP 91-Deep ruby in appearance, with intense aromas of red fruit with subtle notes of peppery spice and vanilla. The palate is fruit-driven, with well-integrated oak; the powerful tannin structure creates a great balance between fruit and intensity.

This wine has a full satisfyingly mouth feel with mature, fully integrated tannins that enhance a soft luscious finish.
